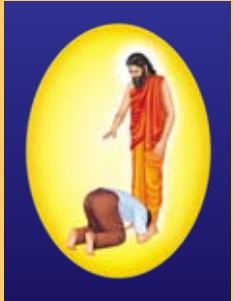

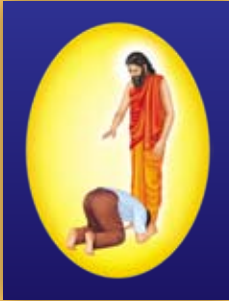

The difference between Sanatan and SIMI

Sanatan's Aim



Acquainting the curious with the science and principles of Spirituality, and guiding them in spiritual practice for God-realisation

Reinstatement of Divine Kingdom (*Dharma Raajya*) to usher in a '*Raam-raajya*' like the just, divine era of Lord Ram wherein society flourished spiritually and materially

SIMI's Aim



Governing of human life on the basis of the Holy Quran,
Propagation of Islam
Jihad for the cause of Islam and there is no room for other religions

SIMI maintains that the concepts of secularism, democracy and nationalism, keystones of the Indian Constitution, are anti-ethical to Islam.



The difference between Sanatan and SIMI

Modus Operandi - Sanatan

All activities are conducted in a peaceful and law abiding manner



Done by developing good seekers of God that respect their fellow man and society at a physical, psychological and spiritual level. Sanatan seekers have a strong national spirit.

Modus Operandi - SIMI

By adopting an extremist and militant position on various issues of concern to the Islamic community



By inducting extremist Muslim student youth and inculcating a seed of hatred and violence as the organization does not believe in a nation-state, it does not believe in the Indian Constitution or the secular order.

Activities - Spiritual



- Imparting spiritual knowledge for the past 18 years and guiding the curious in spiritual practice
- Publishing of various books in many languages on Spirituality and nation-building
- Conducting satsangs for adults and children all over the world to help people grow spiritually
- Law abiding protest against denigration of deities
- Developing *saattvik* pictures and idols of deities

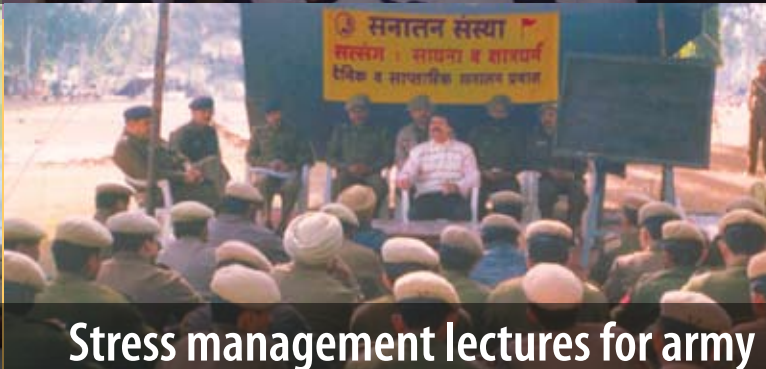

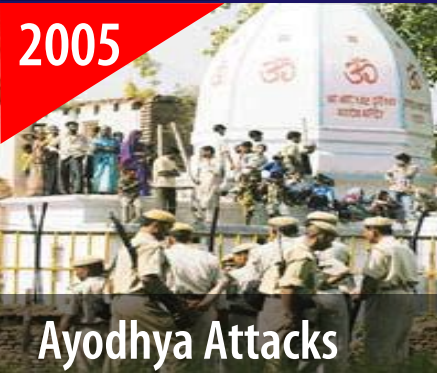

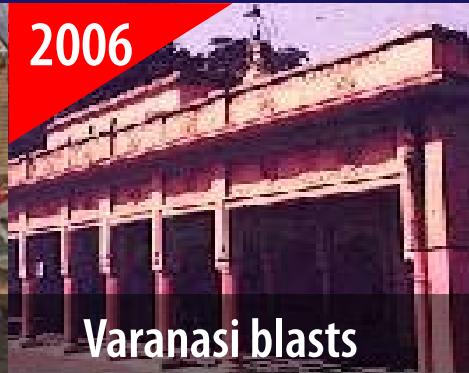

Funding of Sanatan Sanstha



Sale of spiritual books and items

Donations (*arpan*) in cash or kind/service by society

Almost all items in Sanatan ashrams are donated by well wishers and seekers.

Funding of SIMI



Funded by Arab countries and Islamic countries to destabilize India.

What will happen if the ban takes place?

- **Disruption in social service activities and nation building activities**
- **Disruption of spread of Spirituality and education of Dharma**
- **Obstruction in the spiritual practice of seekers of God**
- **Unnecessary wastage of time and resources which could be used for the spread of Spirituality and nation building**
- **Publishing and sale of books on Spirituality would be obstructed**

Even if the ban is placed Sanatan Sanstha and HJS will only grow by leaps just as the RSS grew after being unjustly banned.

When history is written the NCP's name will be blackened for attempting to ban a righteous organisation. The names of Sanatan Sanstha and HJS will take pride of place in India's history.
