PRESS NOTE

Legislate a strict act to stop 'Love Jihad' and impose a ban on conversions and subsequent marriages taking place in Madarasas ! - Mr Pramod Muthalik

A powerful gang of religious fanatics is hatching a sinister conspiracy to lure Hindu and other non-Muslim girls into a dragnet of love and force them to embrace Islam; in the name of 'Love Jihad'. In the month of August 2014, a case has come to the light in which a religious fanatic Rakibul, pretending to be a Hindu tricked a national-level shooter Tara Sahadev and then, forced her to convert to Islam. The resulting nationwide publicity has brought the seriousness of Love Jihad to the forefront. This problem has assumed gargantuan proportions, and hundreds of such cases have already occurred and are still occurring in the States of Maharashtra, Kerala, Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh, Delhi, Uttar Pradesh etc. In order to completely uproot the anti-national conspiracy of 'Love Jihad', an independent and stringent Act should be legislated, and conversions and subsequent marriages taking place in Madarasas should be held illegal and banned. These demands were raised by Mr Pramod Muthalik, Founder of Shriram Sene in a press conference held here in Mumbai.

The press meet was also attended by Advocate Sanjiv Punalekar (Secretary of Hindu Vidhidnya Parishad) and Mr Ramesh Shinde (National Spokesperson of Hindu Janajagruti Samiti). The issue of Love Jihad initially surfaced in the 'Shahan Shah and Sirajuddin Vs. Kerala Government' case. Still, if our Home Minister was in the dark about the phenomenon of 'Love Jihad', we are ready to present the women victimised due to 'Love Jihad' and their relatives before the Home Minister and the public.

Maharashtra Government agrees about the existence of 'Love Jihad' !

Ms. Maneka Gandhi, (Union Minister for Women and Child Welfare) recently stated that there is not a single official complaint about 'Love Jihad': However, in Congress ruled Maharashtra, there are 22 cases of 'Love Jihad' registered with the Police. This official information has been supplied by the Inspector General of Maharashtra Police, under the "Right To Information" Act. Therefore, we demand that Union Home Minister Mr Rajnath Singh and Union Women and Child Welfare Minister Ms. Maneka Gandhi should seek this information from the Maharashtra Government and initiate action against 'Love Jihad' phenomenon.

Mr VS Achuthanandan, (The former CM of Kerala, CPI-M) had also stated that few fanatic organisations in Bharat are indulging in giving effect to 'Love Jihad' cases with financial backing from foreign countries and trying to mould Kerala into an Islamic State. Present Chief Minister of Kerala Oommen Chandy has said that 2,500 girls from the State have been victimised by 'Love Jihad'.

Certain other demands also raised during the press conference.....

1. In order to prevent any danger to the unity and integrity of the Nation, a stringent law should be enacted in the country against deceit and atrocities committed on the women. This Act should make provision for awarding stringent punishment to the accused from the Muslim community on the basis of the statements given by the girls (and their relatives) from a non-Muslim communities like Hindu, Jain, Sikhs, Christian, Buddhist, etc. If the victim wills for a divorce, it should be granted immediately. In the case of such divorce, the victim should be entitled to half the property of the accused.

2. Similarly, the Central Government should initiate high-level inquiry into the supply of funds from foreign countries for inter-religious marriages, human trafficking and their utilisation for terrorist activities. Corrective actions to completely uproot this sinister conspiracy should be initiated.
